The Mid-Maine Homeless Shelter & Services (MMHSS) invites you to participate in the 26th Annual Charity Golf Tournament – your support is critical to ensuring 2023 is our most impactful year ever!

MMHSS offers an emergency shelter 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Our team, including case managers and housing navigators, ensure that most people we serve will find and keep stable permanent housing.

Not only is the immediate housing crisis stopped, simple, decent and affordable housing also creates the condition where people can address other issues in their lives, from accessing education and job training, to finding employment, getting help for addiction, and improving mental health.

None of these challenges are addressed until stable permanent housing is a reality.

That's why five years ago we started a new project devoted to homeless youth called YES which stands for Youth Empowerment Services. We have 11 units of permanently supportive housing for YES program participants, complete with case management and a community outreach worker. Our goal is to empower young people to live independent and stable lives and fully participate in their community.

Over the past 25 years the Golf Tournament has been our signature fundraising event. The funds raised from the Golf Tournament will directly impact the lives of people in our community so there is no better way to make a difference in a problem that feels like it is getting worse by the day.

Ending homelessness is a huge goal and we won't likely see it in our lifetime. But by working together, we can end homelessness for *someone* today. Participation in our Golf Tournament is an investment in our town and in our county and the people and businesses who call this area home.
